

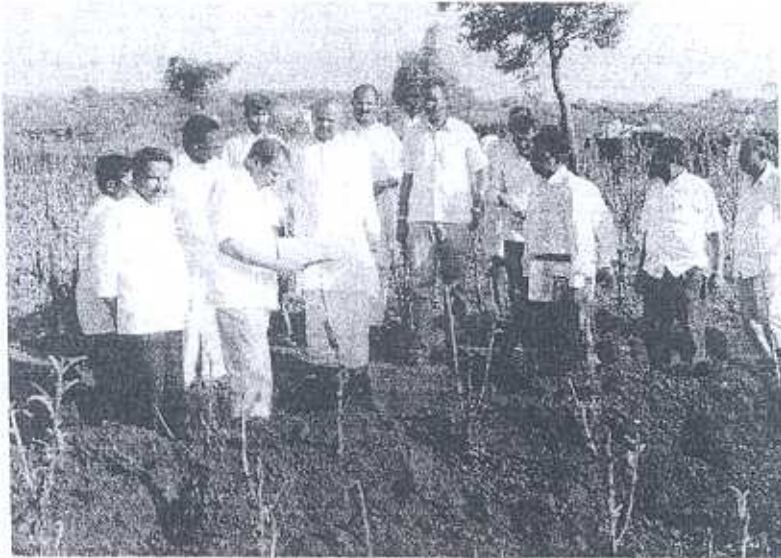
Inspection Report of Sri R.Dhruvanarayana, Member of Parliament, Chamarajanagar Constituency (Karnataka) & Member, Central Employment Guarantee Council regarding inspection of N.R.E.G.A. works at Chennagudi Village (M.C.Talalu Grama Panchayat), H.D.Kote Taluk, Mysore District (Karnataka State) on 16-10-2009.

CHENNAGUDI VILLAGE (M.C.TALALU GRAMA PANCHAYAT):

Inspected the N.R.E.G.A. works taken under Water Shed Development Department in this village. Development of Agriculture Lands of Hill Shepherd (Betta Kuruba) are being done with an estimate cost of Rs.1.50 lakhs & thereby providing improvements in their livelihood . During inspection 18 Forest Shepherd Labourers were working (10 Male & 8 Female). They were paid Rs.85/- (including materials cost). I discussed with the labourers, they opined that, this Central Government Scheme help them for their live & avoided migration for job. But they are not satisfied with the payment of Rs.85/-, they demand minimum Rs.150/-.



While discussion with Officers, they propose for permission to use machinery equipments for digging elephant trench, so that, they can complete the work at an earliest. I direct them to submit the above proposal in NREGA Committee Meeting.

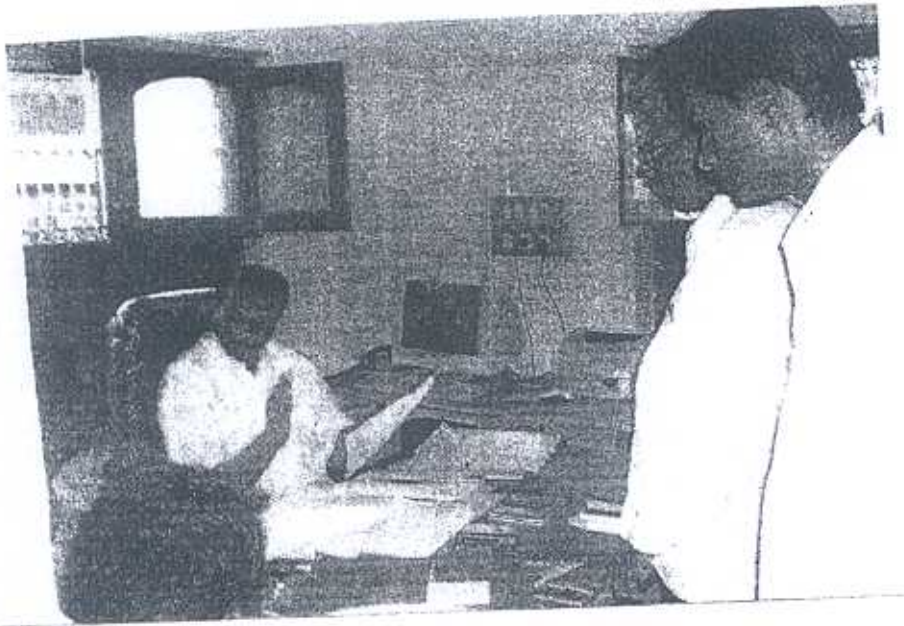

1) GRAMA PANCHAYAT OFFICE, GOWDAHALLI:

Discussed with Grama Panchayat President, Vice-President, Members & Secretary and verified the records. In this village, total population is 1781. Uptodate only 1016 families were registered. Out of this, 595 families applied for job and all of them were given job and till today 11,703 mandays were generated. I instructed the G.P. Secretary to register rest of the villagers for the job at an earliest.

Verified the records and instructed them to record the details of payment in concerned job card and Format-3 Register. Verified the cash register. From 1-4-2009 till today Rs.20.00 lakhs released, Rs.21.15 lakhs available and expenditure made is Rs.10.32 lakhs. I instructed them to utilize the remaining amount and to propose for further instalment.


I instructed them to take more works as this Grama Panchayat has 9 villages with vast lands & there is a possibility of taking more works.



**2) GOVERNMENT SCHOOL PLAY GROUND,
GOWDAHALLI:**

Inspected the Development of Govt. School Play Ground work. This work included in 2008-09 Action Plan. This work has been done by the

Panchayat Raj Engineering Department with an estimate cost of Rs.10.00 lakhs. They made expenditure Rs.9.90 lakhs upto 31-3-2009 and the work done is satisfied. I instructed them to take more Development and asset creating works and thereby give job facility to the local labours and to avoid migration.
